**MONDAY**

**Beginner/Int Watercolor Painting 6-8pm**

**Instructor: Mo Myra**

Learn the basics of watercolor; stretching wet watercolor paper onto special boards, working with techniques of "wet on wet" and "dry brush" in this class for all skill levels. Subjects will be simple landscapes and still life with the goal of learning watercolor control to produce small finished paintings. More advanced techniques for the intermediate student.

**Veterans Drawing, Painting & Collage 10-12noon**

**Silver Soldering 101**

**Silver Bezel Soldering 102**

**October 6-27, 6:30-8:30**

A four week workshop introducing participants to the basics of advancing silversmithing skills. Each student will complete 2 Projects: You will learn to shape, form and set a cabochon pendant and make a prong set ring.

Participants should bring their own materials: 18x24" newsprint pad, charcoal vine, kneaded erasure, white, black and sepia conte, ebony pencil.

**Printmaking Techniques Into Collage 1-3pm**

Explore printmaking methods with results on a variety of papers by learning traditional block-printing, monotype and mono-printing from demonstrations. Creating your own stunning prints is the first step to producing a series of prints. Participants will use sketching exercises and multi-layered printing to develop mixed media collage works. Discover endless possibilities and be inspired while working in a supportive environment. Sessions involve cutting linoleum and rubber with gouges and knives. Careful attention to proper use of tools encouraged. Material fee: \$20 paid to instructor
