- Work must be ready to hang; screw eyes and wire preferred when possible.
- Only two-dimensional works will be accepted not to exceed 36"x48" including the frame.
- Awards: Best in Show, Second Place and Third Place will be selected by a juror and the 'What is Color' committee members. Best in Show - \$150, Second Place - \$75, Third Place - \$50
- By entering this exhibit, the artist agrees to make information regarding the work available for publicity.
- Entry form (see below) must be attached to artwork upon delivery.
- All artwork must be for sale. SoCCA receives 30% commission on sales.
- SoCCA retains the right to refuse any submissions for inappropriate content and may need to refuse works due to excessive quantities.
- SoCCA is not responsible for theft, loss or damage to artwork for any reason.

#### Submission Fees

- \$10 donation to SoCCA per entry One piece may be submitted.
- SoCCA is a non-profit 501c3. All donations support SoCCA's Gallery Program and are used to underwrite exhibit costs. Fees are non-refundable.
